May, following a season of April showers, promises to be a busy and productive month for our community.

Our Annual General Meeting (AGM) will take place on **Wednesday, May 13 at 10:00 a.m.** in the Main Hall of the Recreation Center. Residents can expect to receive the AGM package, which includes all relevant details, in their mailboxes around May 1.

This year, six of the seven Director positions are up for election. Donna Brown (Secretary) will continue in her role for one more year. While a minimum of four Directors is required for quorum, the Board prefers to maintain at least five members to ensure smooth operations and avoid voting deadlocks.

During the voting process, or if thinking of nominating someone from the floor, please keep the following key expectations in mind:

- Basic computer skills: including email use, Condo Control, and report preparation
- A time commitment of approximately six hours per month (this can vary widely depending on responsibilities)
- Ability to work collaboratively within a team
- Willingness to support team-based decisions
- A commitment to prioritizing HHRA's needs over personal preferences

With the arrival of spring, our PRRL Director, Donna McCreary, is actively responding to resident inquiries. She is happy to communicate by email and can arrange property visits to answer questions. Residents are reminded that some contractor work—such as driveway replacement—may require an Encroachment Permit from the Town. This protects homeowners in case of damage to municipal property.

Security improvements were completed with the installation of new hard-wired cameras at building entrances. These replace the existing, older battery-operated units. The cameras (and signage) are intended to deter vandalism, trespassing and break-ins. Please note:

- Cameras are located only at exterior entrances
- Footage is accessed only when necessary for investigations
- All systems comply with government privacy regulations – NO AUDIO is recorded
- Recorded video is subject to a retention and deletion schedule

Parking lot resurfacing is scheduled for this month and dates may be weather permitting. To minimize disruption, work will be completed in phases, with only half of the lot closed at a time. Updates and reminders will be posted through Condo Control.

Additional updates:

- A recent fire inspection identified several items requiring attention
- An external building inspection is being scheduled, as it has been two years since the last review under the Pretium engineering report
