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Summer is in full swing, and many activities are continuing, along with a new addition—Cornhole. Convenors are reminded that if their activities require funding for the 2026–2027 budget year, request forms must be submitted to Gary Jewkes by August 31.

A new red safety box has been installed in the pool area on the exterior wall beside the entrance/exit door. This is important for all residents, not just those using the pool. The box is intended for use in the event of a fire, particularly if evacuation through the pool door is necessary. Please note that the pool door is a fire door and will automatically lock when the fire alarm is triggered. The red box contains keys to the external gates that provide exits from the fenced pool area. A steel rod located at the top of the box can be removed and used to break the glass to access the keys. Additionally, a new shed for chemical storage has been installed in the pool area to replace the previous unit.

The dishwasher in the Craft Room is being replaced. Research is also underway regarding options for replacing the rear exterior decking. This project is funded through the Reserve Fund, and proposed options with associated costs will be presented to residents for a vote at the Information Meeting in October.

There are upcoming challenges related to the Holler, as the software currently used to produce it will be discontinued in October. Discussions and research are ongoing to identify a user-friendly replacement and cost-effective publication options.

A Town Hall meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, August 26, from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. in the Main Hall. All residents are encouraged to attend. This is a resident-led opportunity to share suggestions, ask questions, and engage in community discussion. Please mark your calendars.

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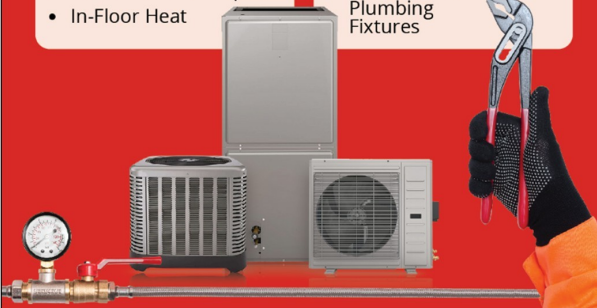
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THE CROSSROADS by C.J.BOX LARGE PRINT

The quest for answers will lead the team deeper and deeper into a quagmire of lies and deception that will force President Ryan to face an unprincipled enemy with global ambitions.

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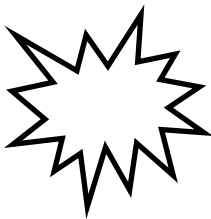

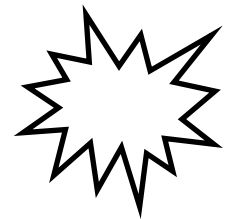
