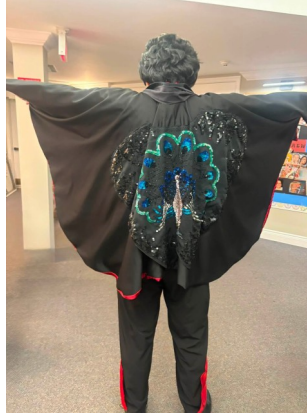
After consulting with Convenors and Residents (survey), the Board has decided to maintain the current policy of not allowing guests to attend scheduled activities. As the Community's demographic continues to change, this decision can be revisited.

During the month of September, the Board is busy reviewing expenditures and creating a budget for the next fiscal year. The Information Meeting to approve the budget is held in October. Details will be released shortly.

From a property maintenance perspective, a number of items are being addressed:

- A new dishwasher has been purchased and installed in the Craft room.
- "Fire Lane" signs will be installed along the driveway at the front entrance to the building, as per the Fire Inspection Report.
- The cleaning and waxing of the floor in the main hall is being scheduled. Details will be announced in Condo Control.
- After reviewing the condition of the rear deck, the Board is postponing the recommended replacement in 2026 and will monitor in Spring 2027.
